John Hanahan Sams (11, 7, 6, 4, 1) was the son of William Sams and his wife, Sarah Adams Reynolds. He was born February 11, 1839, in St. John's Parish, old Colleton County, South Carolina, and died November 28, 1924. He was a graduate of St. Timothy, Baltimore, and served in the Confederate Army. He married March 4, 1865, in Chester, South Carolina, his cousin, Sarah Stanyarne Sams, daughter of Berners Barnwell Sams and his *second* wife, Martha (Edwards) Fripp. She was born July 5, 1840, in Beaufort and died October 6, 1902, in Courtenay, Florida, where both are buried in the churchyard of St. Luke's. They owned "Churchlands Plantation" on John's Island and moved in 1875 to Florida. Issue:

No. 24 Friend St., Tomorrow Morning, at 10 o'clock. (Thursday, February 15, and Friday, February 16.)

Died in Portsmouth, Va. on 9th inst., Mr. James Gaskins, aged 66 years.—In Washington City on 10th inst Mr. Saml M'Intire in 64th year of age.—At N. Y. on the 9th inst. Mr. James M'Gregor, aged 38, native of Scotland.—In Charlestown, Mass. Mr. Saml Munroe, aged 29.—In Salem, Mr. Peter Barrus, aged 77.—In W. Bridgewater, Capt. Eliakim Howard, aged 88.—In Nantucket, 27th ult. Capt. Laban Swaim aged 50; Mr. Valentine Long aged 40.—In Augusta, Ga. on the 15th inst. Capt. David Clark in the 36th yr of age. (Monday, February 19.)

Married on evening of 22d inst. Mr. Chas. Carroll Harper, of Baltimore, to Miss Charlotte H. Chiffelle, dau. of Thos P. H. Chiffelle Esq. of this city. (Monday, February 26.)

Died at Augusta (Ga) on 15th inst. Capt. David Clark in 36th year of his age. (Monday, February 26.)

Death—The Patriarch of Baltimore. On Wed., Feb. 14th in his dwelling in Wagon Alley, Jacob Nurser, in 114th year of age and buried on 16th in burial ground of German Catholic Church of St. John's in Saratoga St. Came to this country when 27 years old from Germany. Served 5 years in Military Service—was at battle and surrender of Lewisburg 1745 and then came to Baltimore and remained until death. At his arrival he found 2 houses on west side of Market street bridge, one belonging to Alex Lawson, the other to Daniel Bernard, who kept a tavern and made soap. Soon after came a single man, Andrew Steiger, a butcher. On the other side of bridge was a little village of seven houses.
