Robert Hardin, in his will, specified which negro girl to go to which unmarried daughter. All mentioned except Rebecca who was too young. Mother Jane rectified that ommission, Feb. 14, 1795, deeding to Matthew Gaston, Green Co., Georgia, married to Jane's daughter "Rebeckah", for love and affection, a negro girl Sall. Jane reserved labor and services of Sall for 5 years. Sall's first child was to go to Rebeckah's daughter Evilin. William Sharpe and John Allen witnessed the will.

Three brothers, Joseph, Robert, and Matthew Gaston, said to be great grandsons of the first Irish William, emigrated to South Carolina, with their sister, Jane Gaston Walker, leaving a fourth brother, Alexander, in Ireland, b. about 1750, d. about 1840; of these Joseph married Martha Gaston, daughter of Justice John (mentioned earlier).

John, d. 1782; married Esther Waugh, d. 1789. . .2. Martha, b. June 11, 1741; married her kinsman, Joseph Gaston, great grandson of the first Irish William (had issue, among others, Alexander, married Mary Blair).
