A BRIEF SKETCH OF THE STRAIT FAMILY OF CHESTER AND YORK COUNTIES, SCUTH CAROLINA

The progenitor of the Strait family of Chester and York Counties, South Carolina, was Christopher Strait, who came to Chester County about 1770. He was a blacksmith and a planter. One record shows that he purchased 500 acres of land on Fishing Creek on September 2, 1774 (Chester Deed Book A, page 124).

The family name was spelled successively Strevdt, Stright, Streight, Straight, and Strait. The Wherrys, a Scotch-Irish family from Pennsylvania who settled in Chester County about 1704, and the Straits were situated as near neighbors in that part of the county several miles southwest of Upper Fishing Creek Presbyterian Church, near the South Fork of Fishing Creek and in close proximity to the old Saluda Road, which originally ran from the Catawba Indian Nation to Saluda Cld Town, on the opposite side of South Carolina from York and Chester Counties.

Christopher Strait was born in 1739. His place of birth is not known at this writing (1974). He died in South Carolina on January 14, 1816, and was buried in the cemetery of Upper Fishing Creek Church. His first wife (the mother of his children) was (Mrs.) Mary (__?_) kemer, who was the mother-in-law of the Reverend John Simpson, founding pastor of Upper Fishing Creek Church (founded about 1770-1771). She was bout in 1736 and died in South Parolina on August 29, 1784. Christopher Strait and (Mrs.) Mary Remer were married about 1761. Issue:

ADDENDA AND HINTS FOR FUTURE INVESTIGATION

1. From Lost Links, a book from the Rock Hill Public Library:

Julia Elizabeth Posey, daughter of Pleasant Milton and Caroline (Porter) Posey, of Tennessee, married on August 16, 1860, Dr. James L. Strait, surgeon of the Confederate States Army. Their children were (1) John Milton Strait, who died at age 19; (2) Emma Caroline Strait, who married Dr. W. K. Gray; and (3) Mary Adeline Strait, who married W. C. King.

It is perfectly possible that Dr. James L. Strait is a descendant of Christopher Strait through one of the Strait grandchildren who removed from South Carolina to Mississippi and Alabama before the Confederate War.

2. Marriage dates taken from old newspapers:

Mrs. E. D. Strait married J.(R?)F. Hinson on February 13, 1868

Rebecca Jane Strait married John B. Wylie on June 4, 1859

Richard R. Strait married Mrs. Mary McLean on January 11, 1859

- 3. Jacob Fox Strait received a letter from his "Aunt Margaret," who lived near Pleasant Ridge Church and near "Columbus's house."
- 4. Francis Marion Steele was the son of Alexander and Elizabeth (Edwards) Steele. He married Mrs. E. E. Black (nee Strait). Issue: (1) Mary Virginia, no children; (2) James Alexander, no children; (3) Wm. Lawrence, 5 children; (4) Augustus C., children; (5) Laura Georgia, 3 children in Texas; (6) Sarah 5 children; (5) Laura Georgia, 2 children; (7) Steele Steele, Antoinette, married a Meekins, 2 children; (7) Steele Steele, married Irene Hardy, 2 children in Navasota, Texas.

5. In either January or February, 1974, there was an obituary in The State newspaper of a retired fireman of the Camden (S.C.) Fire Department, Andrew R. Maver, Sr., aged 78 years. He was a son of the late Leonard Strait and Susan (Ingram) Mayer. The survivors were Andrew R., Jr., and Jimmie Maver, of Camden, sons; Mrs. Margaret Whitley, of Charlotte, N.C., a daughter; Frank Mayer, of Camden, a brother; and Miss Emily Mayer, of Columbia, S.C., a sister.

It would be interesting to learn whether the name <u>Leonard</u>
<u>Strait Maver</u> indicated a blood relationship with the family of Leonard Strait, of Chester County, S.C., deceased.

- 6. There is an article on the four Strait brothers who fought in the Confederate War in The Rock Hill Herald, May 31, 1899. John Strait, William Strait, George W. Strait, and Thomas Strait fought as memoers of Co. A, 17th S.C.V., W. H. Edwards, captain, and Willis Wherry Neely, lieutenant. William and George W. Strait died in service.
- 7. Capt. W. H. Edwards wrote an excellent and lengthy article about the Strait family in military service, probably in The Chester Reporter, about November 24, 1916. The article bears that date.
- 8. Volume I, page 799, Compendium of American Genealogy, found in the Rock Hill Public Library. There is a reference to an immigrant settler to one of the Northern states -- his name, Christian Streydt. The Anglicized spelling would be, of course, Christopher Strait. Investigation into this line might yield the European country of origin of the Strait family of South Carolina. The name sounds either Dutch or German.
- 9. Minutes of Fishing Creek Church, baptized April 8, 1810, Christopher Strait Thompson, son of John Thompson. This entry indicates that the Christian name of Mary Strait's husband (see page 9, above) was John.
- 10. Minutes of Fishing Creek Church, Christopher and Rose Strait were dismissed in 1802 to join another church in the area. It would probably be correct to say that they became members of bethesda Presbyterian Church, York County, S.C. Bethesda Church is not far from the Chester County lime.

Franklin County, north of Quentin, Mississippi. Married first on January 1, 1835, to Selicia Beck, who lived only a year. Married second on January 11, 1837, to Anne Williams, widow of Ervin Lee. She was born on December 21, 1811, at Second Creek, Adams County, Mississippi. Died June 25, 1851, at Franklin Co., Miss. She was the daughter of John Williams. Issue:
