1824--Dr. [Buckner] Lanier and ____ Hagans

Johnston and Perry-MacAliley [Chester Co.-Lancaster Co.

1826--Johnston's Ford shows on Mills' Atlas south of Davy's Island

--- [Before 1871 a ferry from John S. Perry's Mill was operated by Johnston and Perry

1871--Samuel McAliley of Chester County

before both prongs join together from the railroad tracks crossing over the National Grid.
