After the Treaty of Nation Ford in 1840, the Catawba Indians traded away their rights to the reservation for \$21,000. All former leaseholders were then required by the State of South Carolina to have their land surveyed in order to gain clear title.

In 1790 a Federal law passed prohibiting white settlers or states from acquiring Indian Land unless the transaction was ratified by Congress. The Treaty of Nation Ford had not been ratified. In 1980, The Catawba's filed a federal land claim lawsuit which cast a shadow over 62,000 York and Lancaster landowners. The lawsuit was settled in 1993 for \$50 million dollars.
