JOHN MILAM born 1725 (6, 16)* lived in Bradley Creek, Halifax County, Virginia (6), probably came there from Culpepper County (11), was living in 1788, probably died about 1800.

Halifax County records show various deeds, one among others dated October 1, 1764, from John Milam to 700 acres on Bradley Creek (7). His wife was JUDITM (11, 23).
