YORK COUNTY EDUCATION ASSOCIATION YEAR BOOK 1928-1930

The report included an "Approved List of Rosenwald Schools of York County" as follows:

In the above list next to Ogden (Crawford) the notation "+Carroll" is written in. I believe this indicates that the new Carroll Rosenwald School was being added to the list and was under the same school board as the Crawford School.

Each yearly report includes a list of "Colored" teachers for the African American schools. I copied the listing for Crawford School for several years as follows:

1936-37 York County Year Book:

Crawford: L. B. Moore, Jr., Bleka Moore, Ellore Graham, Ella B. Featherstone

Note: After the 1932-33 Year Book, no African American schools were identified as Rosenwald schools in the lists.
