Chamfered pilasters remain at porch. Left elevation: primary side gable projection with details similar to front gable except without window hood; secondary side gable with boxed cornice and returns. Right elevation: single 6/6 window; triple 1/1, 6/6 in rear gable extension; rear gable end with boxed cornice and returns; 6/6 window, 6/6 windows at facade, 4/4 at side elevations.
