He was reared by Mrs. Ann Thorn, of the Hanging Rock community, now in her ninetieth year, who visited him recently at Rock Hill, and was able to attend his funeral also. She took charge of him when he was an orphan of tender years.
		The funeral services were conducted in Bethany Baptist church, the following ministers taking part in the services: Rev. W. J. Sprinkle, pastor of the Northside Baptist church, Rock Hill who accompanied the remains; Rev. A. E. Fulner, a former pastor of Mr. Williams; Rev. P. E. Blackmon pastor of Bethany church, and Rev. J. M. Neal, of Kershaw. The remains were laid to rest with the ceremonies of the Woodmen of the World, of which order Mr. Williams was a member, in the presence of a large number of relatives and friends, a number of whom accompanied the family from Rock Hill.
